

Jiffy Bean Bag (crocheted)

In need of bean bags and no time to wait for mail delivery? With a little ingenuity, this pattern and scrap yarn, several bags can be made up in a jiffy!

Skill Level: Beginner

Yarn Description:

- Any machine washable 3- or 4-ply yarn

Crochet Hook:

- J-10/6mm

Other Materials Needed:

- Metal bent-tip tapestry needles
- Dry beans (samples used 1.5 bags)

Gauge: Gauge is not required for this pattern.

***Note:** Read ALL these instructions thoroughly BEFORE starting to crochet. The size of bags knitted can be easily changed, depending upon the number of rows you choose to crochet prior to closing.*



Abbreviations Used:

Ch - Chain

Sl st - Slip Stitch

Lvng - Leaving

St/sts - Stitch(es)

Rpt - Repeat

Rmv - Remove

Sc - Single Crochet

In - Inch

BO - Bind off

Instructions:

Ch 34.

1. Sc in 2nd ch from hook; sc across. Ch 1, turn. (33sc)
2. Sc in each st across; ch 1, turn. (33sc)
3. Rpt #2 until piece measures 5"/12.7cm; approximately 18 rows.
4. Fold piece in half; sl st seam along top and down one side. Cut yarn lvng 10-12in tail, BO, secure and weave in loose ends.
5. Turn piece outside out and fill w/dry beans.
6. Using remaining yarn, sew side opening securely closed. BO, secure yarn end and weave in loose end.
