



Solen-Briller Pocket



Materials:

- 2 skeins color of choice worsted-weight yarn
 - Sample used
 - Red Heart Super Saver #0633 Dark Sage
 - Red Heart Fiesta in Buff
- J(10)/6.0mm crochet hook
- Stitch markers
- Large blunt tip needle
- 1 large sew-on snap
- Sewing needle and thread matching yarn choice
- 1 matching or contrasting button – size/type of choice

Gauge: (gauge obtained with I(9)/5.5mm crochet hook)

11 single crochet (sc) = 4"

11 half double crochet (hdc) = 4"

11 double crochet (dc) = 4"

Abbreviations:

Sc = single crochet

Hdc = half double crochet

Ch = chain

St(s) = stitch(es)

Sl st = slip stitch

St mrk(s) = stitch marker(s)

Rpt = repeat

INSTRUCTIONS: (two strands are held throughout)

1. Create a slipknot and ch 22; sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; ch1, turn. (21sts)
2. Sc in next st and in each st across; ch1, turn.
3. Repeat step 2 until 24rows total has been completed.
4. Flap:
 - a. *Ch1, sl st 2nd st; sc in next st; hdc in next 17sts; sc in next st; sl st last 2sts; turn*.
 - b. Repeat * *, until 4 rows total completed; cut yarn; bind off securely and weave in loose ends.
5. Assembly:
 - a. Fold 1st 24 rows completed in half, and secure each side with 2 st mrkr.
 - b. Using tapestry needle and 2 strands of yarn used, sew side seams using a whip stitch. Secure and weave in loose ends.
 - c. Using sewing needle and thread, attach snap evenly aligned on pocket and flap, securely.
 - d. Securely attach button in center on front of flap above snap.
